GUESTS: Troy Otterson, Tavern on the Range – Otterson informed Council that his

property taxes and sales taxes are paid in full. He requested forgiveness of his utility late fees because the County forgave his property tax late fees. He also requested help with a sign he would like displayed. Council informed him the sign must go through D.O.T. Meyer stated she feels it benefits the city to have a restaurant/bar and requested Council consider a late-fee compromise. Council

discussed the situation but was unable to agree on a solution.

Bob Tok- recently received an \$850 invoice from the city per a verbal agreement pertaining to tree removal. He advised that 2.5 ft of the 4th Street right-a-way is in his garage. He is willing to pay the invoice in full if the city corrects this issue. It was discussed that this should be brought up with planning and zoning first and was tabled until the next meeting.
